Rental includes electricity and water at rear of space. Please specify voltage needed on registration form below. Electric hook up requires 30 amp 125 volt plug in "NEMA TT-30R." If additional amperage is required, you will need to provide your own generator that has an attached muffler.

The Georgia Marble Festival Committee, the Pickens County Chamber of Commerce and any and all persons, property owners, suppliers, volunteers and entities connected with the 2010 Georgia Marble Festival are not liable for damages, injury or loss to any person or goods from any cause whatsoever. All Vendors, their heirs, administrators, and executors do hereby waive and release all of the above named from any and all claims or damages of whatever arising out of the vendors' participation in the 2010 Georgia Marble Festival.

Vendors must exhibit for the entire show. **Early breakdown will not be permitted.** There is no rain date-come prepared rain or shine. Set-up is allowed during allotted times only. Booths must be set-up and ready for business by 9:30 am on Saturday and 9:00 am on Sunday. Booth must always be manned during festival hours. If you miss the gate closing at 9:30 am on Saturday, you may set-up Sunday beginning at 7:30 am and be ready for business by 9:30 am. Vendors are responsible for setting up booth and collecting sales tax.

Vendors are responsible for cleanup of area.

This is a juried arts & crafts show. All items sold inside the art and craft booths area **must be hand made or natural products**. No commercially produced products will be allowed. Only products that are approved by the jurying committee will be allowed. **These rules will be enforced!**

No promotional products or materials will be allowed to be distributed or sold. No clothing items may be sold or distributed that have advertisements for any causes, businesses or products on them.

No political material or fund raising for causes will be allowed inside the arts & crafts booth area.

Music is restricted to the Entertainment Stage only. If you require music to be played, earphones must be used.

Acceptance letters will be mailed promptly after jury process is completed.

Food booths may be assigned a specific time to be here. That is determined by vendor's set-up.

Only 20oz. Coca Cola products are to be sold. These must be purchased through the Pickens County Chamber of Commerce.

The Marble Festival Committee holds the right to remove from our mailing list vendors who display, or have displayed in the past, unprofessional behavior.

The Marble Festival Committee holds the right to remove any vendor from the Marble Festival who does not adhere to the above rules & regulations.

To: All Food Vendors for the 30th Annual Marble Festival

We are pleased to announce that the Coca Cola Company of Jasper has agreed to be a major sponsor for the 30th Annual Marble Festival.

Since they are a major sponsor and have exclusive rights, **only 20 oz. Coca Cola products are to be sold. These must be purchased through the Pickens County Chamber of Commerce.** They will be available at the Coca Cola Trailer on the festival grounds and will cost \$18.00 per case of 24, or \$.75 each. We ask that you charge our patrons \$1.50 or less per drink. The \$18.00 per case cost is less than what you would pay if you purchased this product directly from Coke (\$19.25 for 50 cases or more). We feel we are providing a good deal for our vendors, our patrons and our Chamber.

The only exceptions to this new drink policy will be those vendors offering home-made tea, home-made lemonade and the smoothie or slushy type drinks.

In addition, your initial supply of ice (20lbs) and Coca-Cola Cooler will be given to you to use during the festival. Additional ice may also be purchased at the Coca-Cola truck inside the Festival gates for \$2.00 per 20 lb bag.

Upon approval by the Food Vendors Committee, you will receive a list of Coca Cola products that will be available to you for purchase from the Chamber. Instruction for ordering, payment and pick-up will also be included.

We are looking forward to seeing you at this year's Georgia Marble Festival. Thank you for your participation and support of the Pickens County Chamber of Commerce.
