Purpose

In order for Pickens County to achieve its potential, the people must be aware of the social, economic, educational, and governmental needs of the community.

The participants will benefit significantly from getting to know each other during the formal and informal exchange of ideas and experiences. They will also gain knowledge from the overall program, preparing them for a more active leadership role in the community.

Participants

The program consists of nine regularly scheduled sessions from September to May. Most sessions will be held the third Thursday from around 8:00 am until 5:00 pm with one weekend retreat included. The class program will focus on team building and enhancing the quality of life by better understanding local issues such as education, government, healthcare, economic development, and community service.



Eligibility

The Leadership Pickens Steering Committee desires to include a diversified group in terms of race, sex, and occupation. Individuals from business, social services, government, cultural, and educational organizations will comprise the class. Class members must live and/or be employed in Pickens County.

Acceptance

The individual interested in participating in the program must complete a detailed application and it must be returned to the Pickens County Chamber of Commerce no later than **July 31, 2018**. The information contained in the application will be used in the enrollment process. Class size will be limited to twenty participants.

Applicants will be notified by August 13, 2018 with tuition of \$475 being due by **August 31, 2018**.
