3. All applications are subject to approval by the parade committee.
4. Applicant must agree in writing to abide by the disclaimer above.
5. **Notice of parade position & arrival time will be sent via email by October 4, 2023.** This information is not available prior to this date. Failure to arrive as scheduled will result in a position change.
6. Subject to entry type, proof of insurance rider may be required.
7. Floats will be judged, and trophies awarded to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winners!
8. Absolutely no candy may be thrown from vehicles. Walkers may hand out candy on the parade route.
